Professional guided city tour of Nashville. You'll be hosted around Nashville and exposed to the best of Music City. Learn about the Athens of the South and gather interesting facts about Nashville's history, industries and famous people. Tour sites include Nashville downtown area, State Capitol, Fort Nashborough, Riverfront Park, The Ryman Auditorium, Centennial Park & the Parthenon, Music Row's Recording Studios, Vanderbilt University, Belmont College and many other points of interest.

Free time on historic 2nd Avenue (downtown) for shopping, etc. with lunch on own.

Admission included to the **Ryman Auditorium** for a **self-guided tour**. Ryman Auditorium is a National Historic Landmark and must see for anyone visiting Nashville. Most famous as the home of the Grand Ole Opry from 1943-1974, its history as Nashville's premier theater and central gathering place started even before construction was complete in 1892. You'll discover the divine inspiration behind the building's construction as the Union Gospel Tabernacle in the 1880's in our welcome video. Explore its rich entertainment history and how the Ryman became known as the "Carnegie Hall of South", "Mother Church of Country Music", and "Birthplace of Bluegrass".

Immerse yourself in the proud tradition of the great showboats of yesteryear and delight in the panoramic sights of the scenic Cumberland River as you enjoy a leisurely lunch cruise which includes live entertainment.
